To all Parents:

The Dallas Junior Police Academy is a full-day learning experience sponsored by the Dallas Police Department. The purpose of this event is to provide education/information to the students who attend. Those attending will leave with a realistic view of law enforcement and the opportunities a career in law enforcement would afford. During the day, the students will enjoy a "hands on" experience of the Police Academy, learn about the equipment in a Police patrol car, and have one-on-one interaction with law enforcement professionals. You will be notified when your child's application has been accepted or has not been accepted to participate in the Dallas Junior Police Academy.

Classes will be held on Saturday, March 31st, and Saturday, April 21st, 2012. Seventy students will be selected for each class. All students must be in the 4th, 5th, 6th, or 7th grade. Each applicant must have the signature of a member of their current school staff indicating approval—based on school performance and character. Classes will be held at the Dallas Police Academy, 5310 Red Bird Center Drive, Dallas, Texas 75237.

Students are to wear school-appropriate attire: shirts with inappropriate language, shorts, sandals, flip-flops or tank tops WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. Students will be outside part of the day and should dress accordingly, including comfortable walking/exercise shoes. If the student has any food allergies, they should be noted on the application. All students will be required to check in between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM. The Academy will begin at 9:00 AM, where they will be welcomed by a Deputy Chief of the Dallas Police Department. Lunch will be provided. At 4:45 PM, parents are invited to attend the graduation of their students from the Dallas Junior Police Academy. The graduation will conclude at 5:15 PM, and a "goody bag" and certificates will be distributed. There will also be a drawing for an Apple IPOD Shuffle and other special prizes for the students.

***\$5.00 Pizza lunch to be paid by student at check-in. Scholarships are available.
To help defer transportation costs, upon request,
fee will be waived when parent/guardian brings the student to enrollment.***

Transportation is not provided. Upon arrival, parents/guardians will be responsible for registering their child and providing verification of transportation at the end of the day. No child will be allowed to leave with anyone other than their parent/guardian without prior written approval from their parent/guardian and showing the proper ID at the time of pickup.
