“Pay up or Get Locked UP!” Warrant Roundup is now underway; City Marshals and Dallas Police will arrest those with outstanding warrants

Dallas, TX - The City of Dallas is joining forces with other law enforcement agencies to participate in the “Pay Up or Get Locked Up!” Summer Warrant Roundup of individuals with outstanding arrest warrants.

The City is now participating in the Scofflaw program in which offenders that are delinquent in satisfying their City of Dallas warrants and outstanding citations are subject to a hold being placed on their vehicle registration renewal. In addition, defendants may face arrest as well as a hold being placed on renewal of their driver’s licenses.

Persons with warrants and outstanding City citations may avoid vehicle registration, driver’s license holds or arrests by paying their citations at:

- 106 S. Harwood (wheelchair access is at 2014 Main Street) Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturdays 8 a.m. to noon
OR
- City of Dallas Marshal’s Office, 1600 Chestnut St., 24 hours/seven days a week (only full payments accepted at this location)
