City to begin Scofflaw enforcement and Warrant Roundup Saturday; Officers will arrest persons with outstanding City of Dallas warrants

What: The Dallas City Marshal's Office will conduct a warrant roundup of individuals with outstanding arrest warrants for unpaid traffic and non-traffic citations. Offenders who are delinquent in satisfying their City of Dallas warrants are subject to arrest, to a hold being placed on renewal of their Vehicle Registration with the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (Scofflaw Program) or denial of their driver's license renewal.

Persons with outstanding citations in the City of Dallas may avoid arrest, vehicle registration holds or denial of their driver's license renewal by paying in person at 106 S. Harwood between 7:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, (wheelchair access is at 2014 Main Street) and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to noon.
