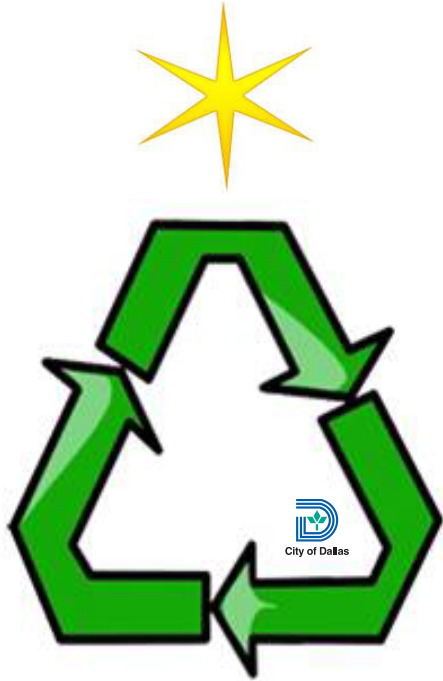


Christmas Tree Recycling



**After the holidays, don't trash your natural tree!
Instead:**

- Place the Christmas tree in your garden or backyard. Fresh orange slices or strung popcorn will attract birds and they can sit in the branches for shelter. Within a year, the branches will become brittle and you can break the tree down for backyard composting.
- Place your tree on the curb for monthly bulk trash collection (Don't put it out too early)
- Drop your tree off at one of the tree recycling sites listed below. We will reward you with some free mulch. (Bring your own container to the Bachman Transfer Station site.)

Important: Remove all ornaments, tinsel, lights, and other non-organic decorative materials including tree stands.
